WHAT IS CODE COMPLIANCE?


- Code Compliance Goal:

WHAT HAPPENS TO YOUR COMPLAINT?

We can only address what we can see from the street right of way as well as to and from the front door.

> We must have clear evidence of the violation that can be presented to the Special Magistrate if needed.

No peeking in windows, over fencing, or wandering on the property.


We are required to provide adequate time to correct the violation(s); except for repeat violations.

City Code Section 16-34. - Placement at curb, outside premises, etc., for collection.

These containers shall not be placed at the curb or roadside any earlier than 5:00 p.m. of the day prior to regularly scheduled collection. All emptied containers shall be returned to proper storage on the premises of the owner no later than 8:00 a.m. on the day following the day of regularly scheduled collection. The term "proper storage" shall mean that these solid waste containers and recyclable materials containers shall be stored between collection days in side or rear yards and not front yards.

An owner who violates the provisions of this section shall be subject to a fine, in the amount of twenty-five dollars (\$25.00), for each day that a violation occurs.
