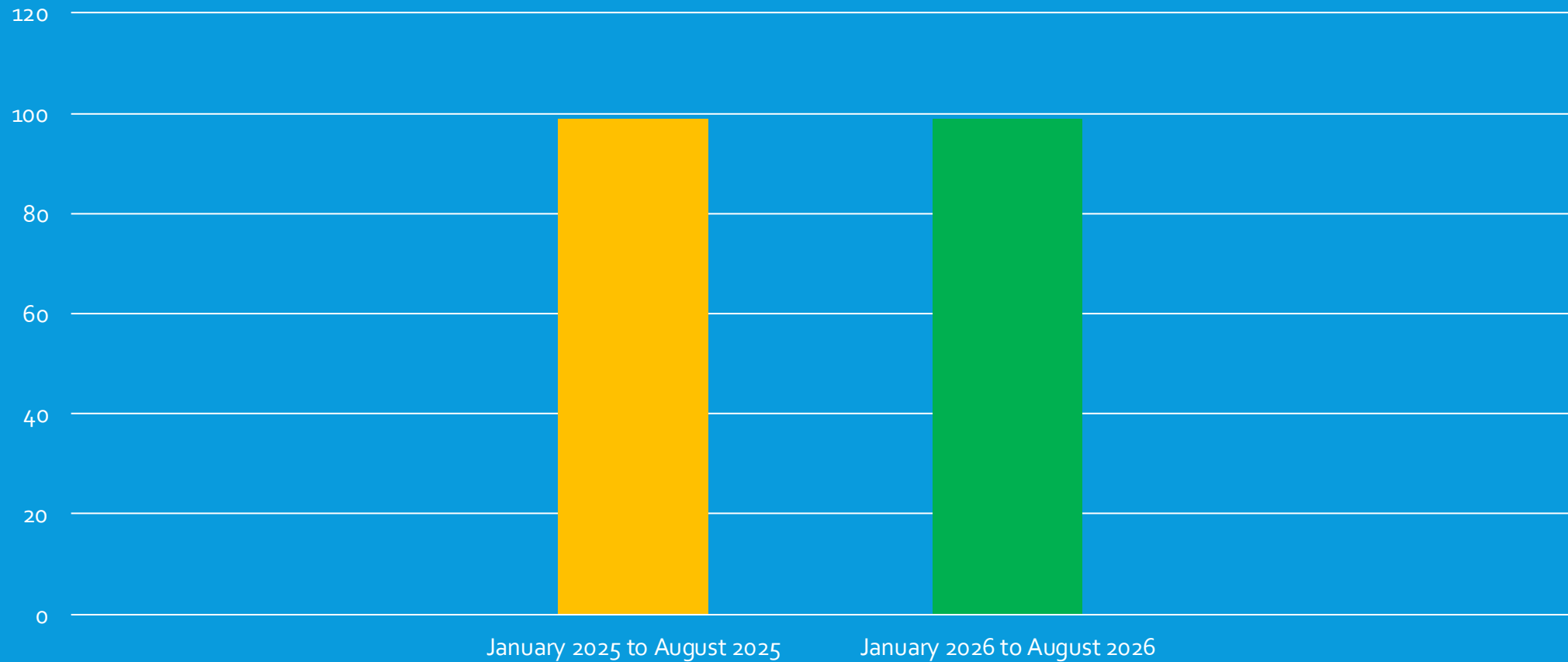

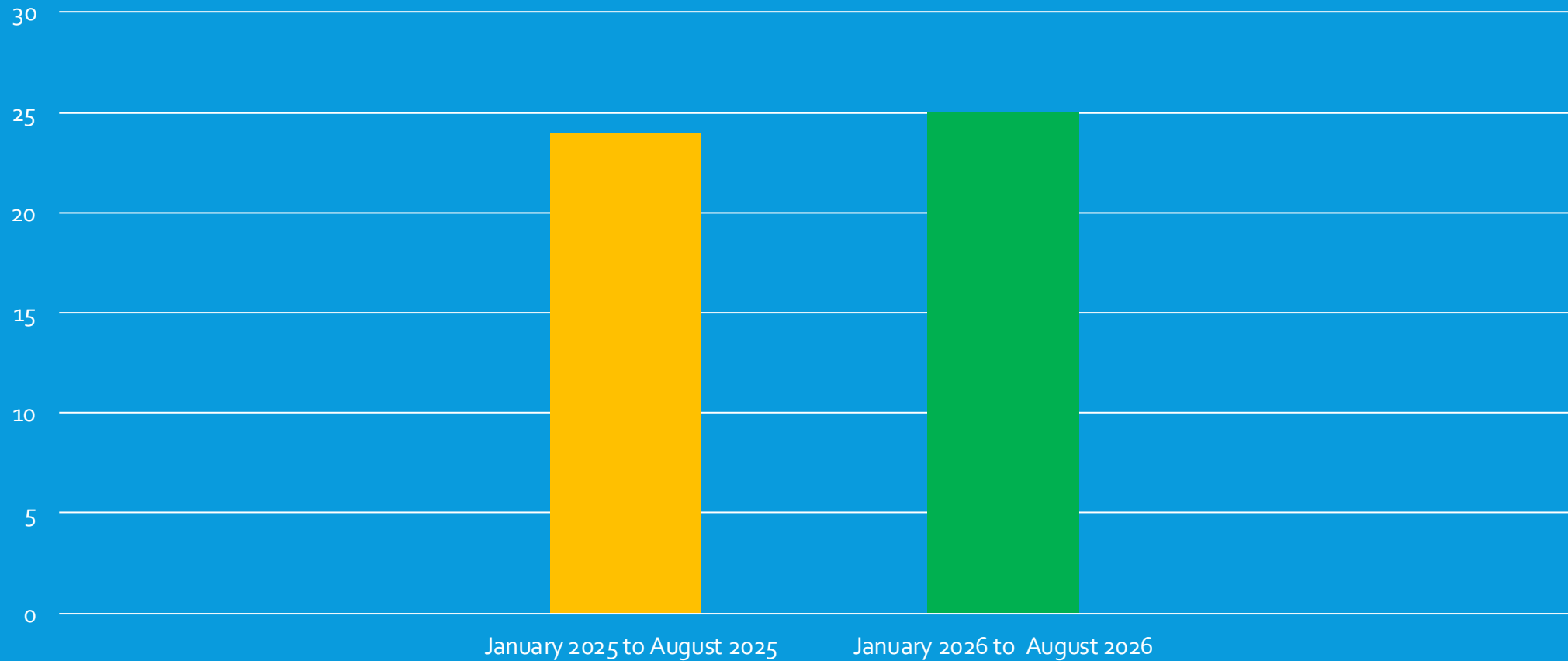

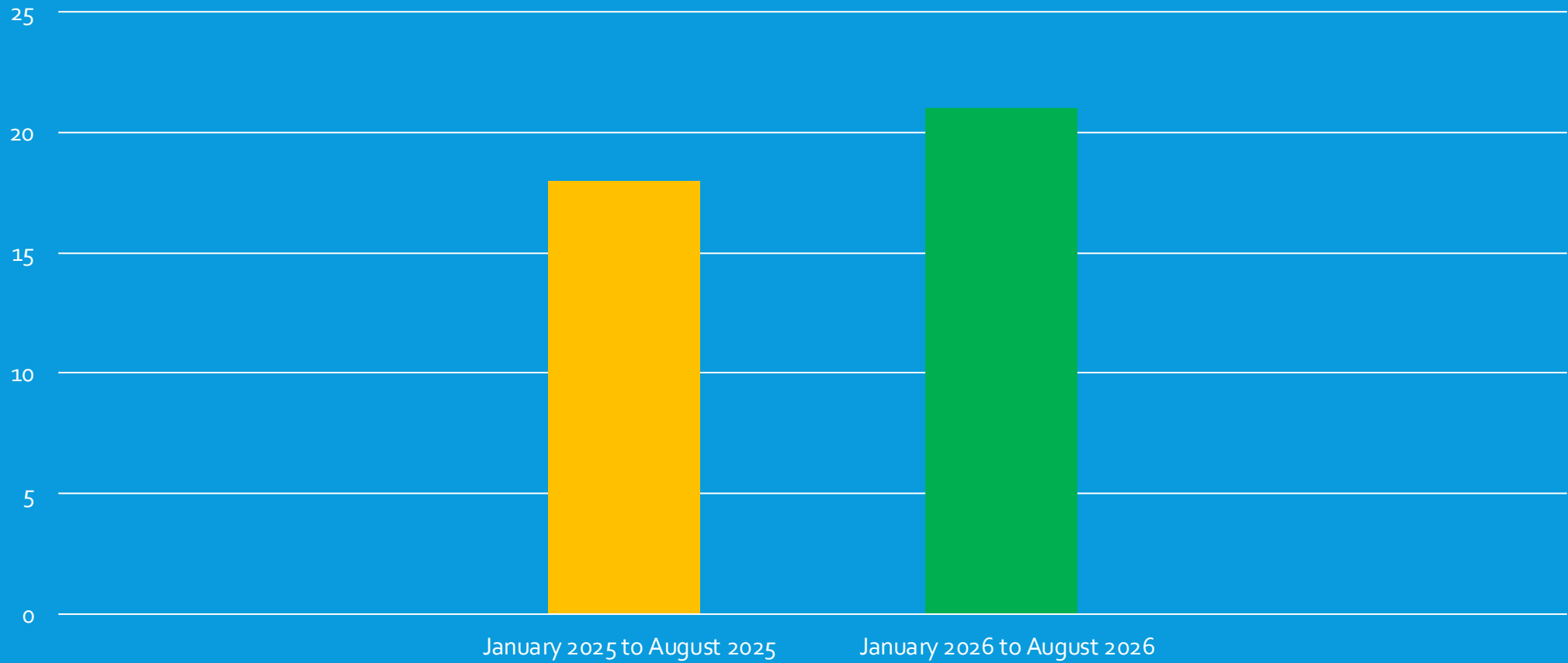

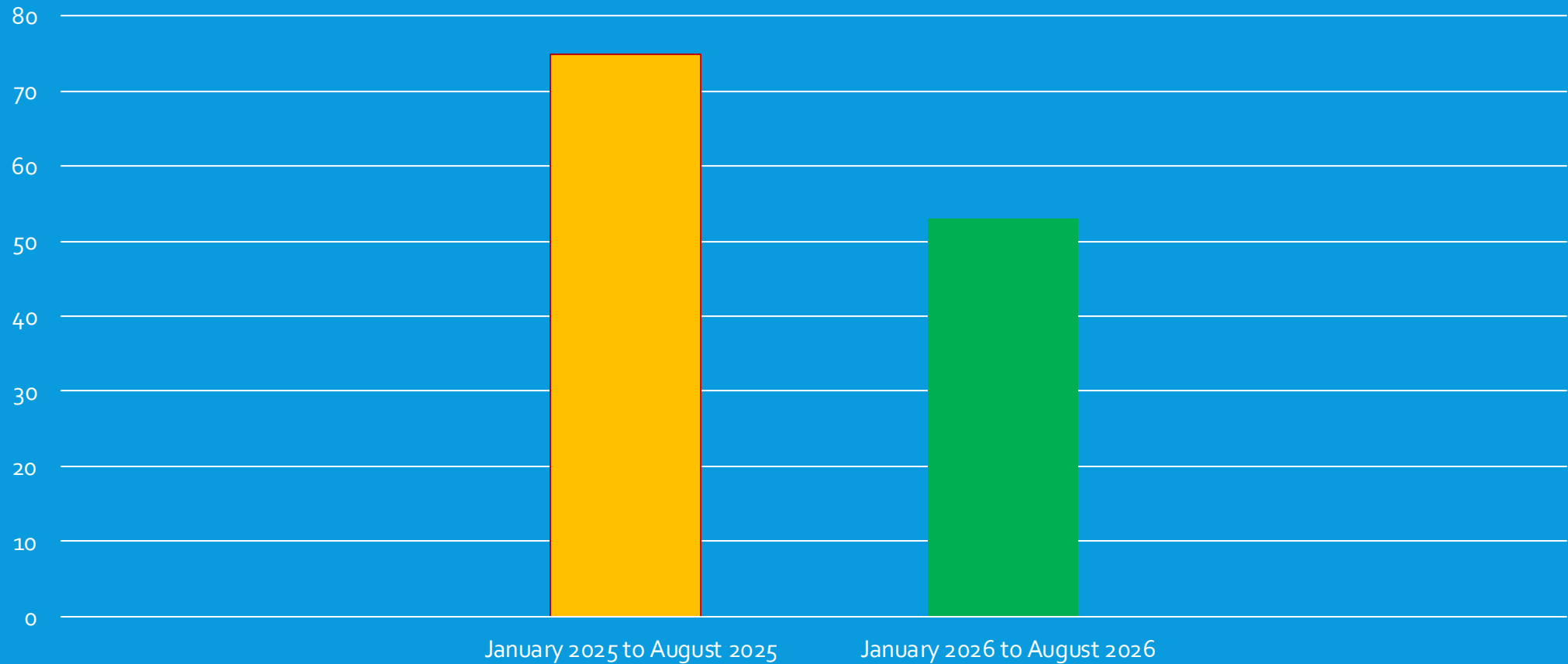

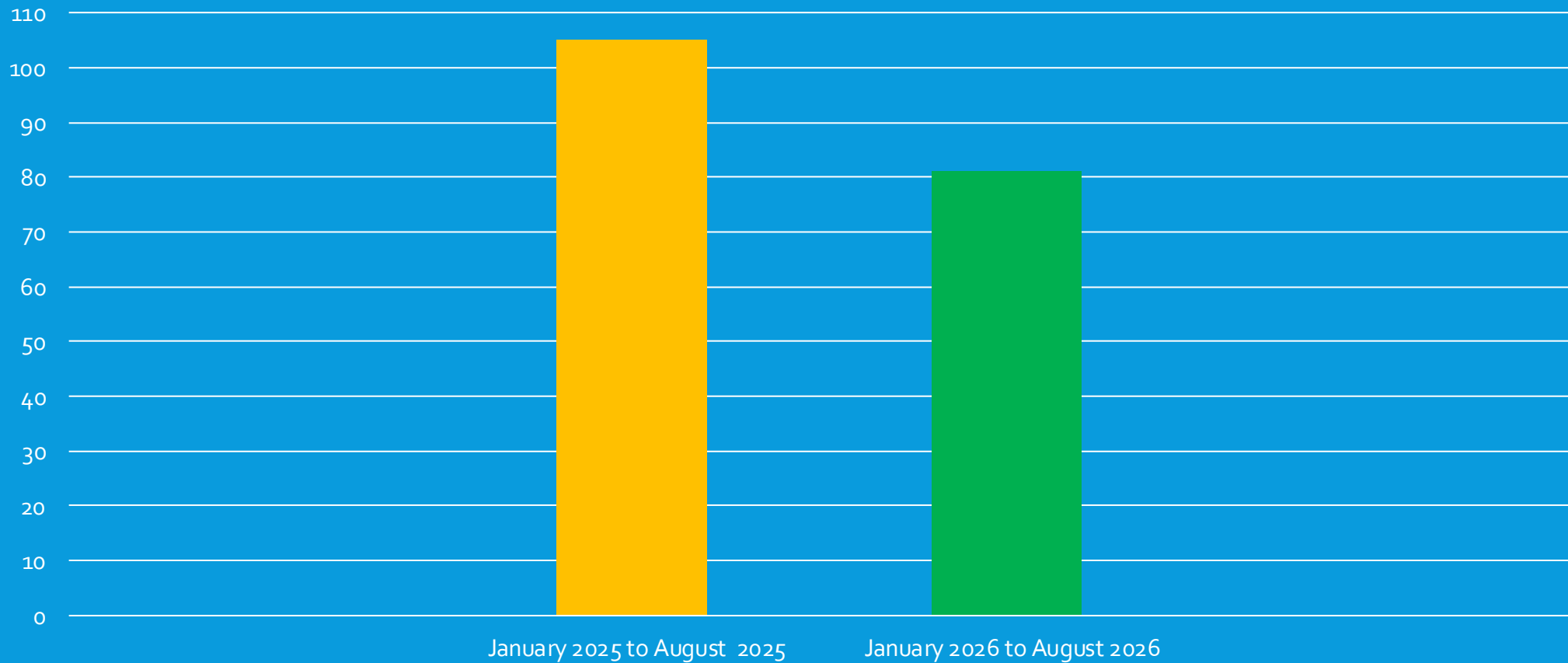

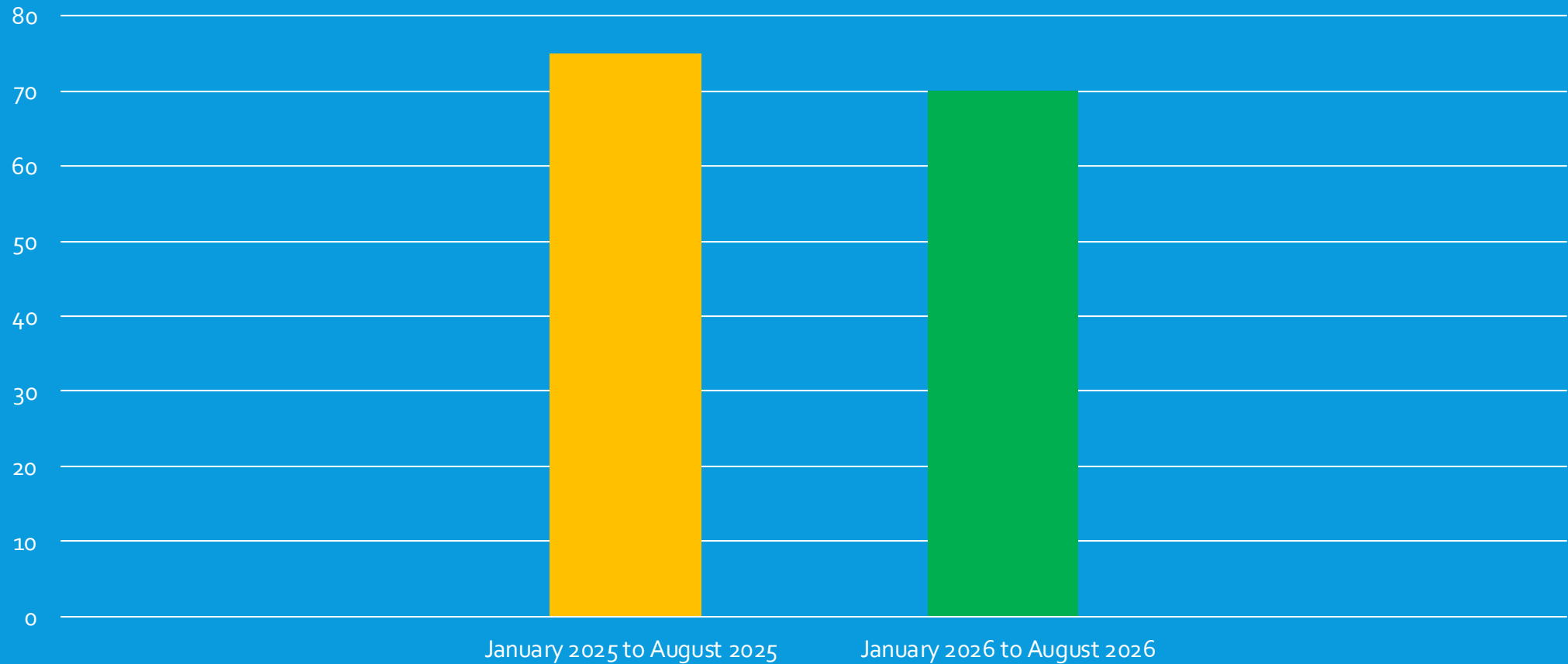


LARCENY FROM VEHICLE

CRIME PREVENTION TIP: HOW TO IDENTIFY AND AVOID PHISHING ATTACKS



How to Protect Yourself :

Never provide your personal information in response to an unsolicited request

If you believe the contact may be legitimate, contact the financial institution yourself

Never provide your password over the phone or in response to an unsolicited internet request.

Review account statements regularly to ensure all charges are correct

CRIME PREVENTION TIP: HOW TO IDENTIFY AND AVOID PHISHING ATTACKS

What to do if your fall victim to phishing and ways to fight:

Contact your financial institution immediately and alert it to the situation.

If you have disclosed sensitive information in a phishing attack, you should also contact one of the three major credit bureaus and discuss whether you need to place a fraud alert on your file, which will help prevent thieves from opening a new account in your name.
