

-Attainable Housing Dashboard- The dashboard is live on the City Website and is available to both employees and the public. This is scheduled to be presented at the **CC Meeting on 9/21/26**.

-Cultural Heritage Display- “Echoes of Sarasota” is now on view in City Hall and the Van Wezel. An Opening Reception is scheduled for City Hall at 4pm on 9/17/26.

-Fresh Fridays Projection Art- The PAC approved moving forward with a projection art program by the Ringling College students for the 11/6/26 Fresh Fridays Event on Palm.

-Marian Anderson Amendment to Purchase and Sale Agreement- This is scheduled for the **CC Meeting on 9/8/26**.

-Newtown Thriving Community Presentation- There was a presentation of the 3D visualization video and discussion on the future of the MLK Corridor at the Newtown Business Council Meeting at Robert L Taylor Tuesday evening. The meeting was very well attended (130+) and went extremely well.

-One Stop Shop Public Art- A call for artists has been issued to provide public art for the One Stop Shop. Submittals are due by this coming Monday.

-Parking Open House and Workshop- The City held an open house focused on the city’s parking program Monday evening in the Commission Chamber at City Hall. It was very well attended, and staff received a large number of questions and recommendations. The power point and public feedback were forwarded to the CC for the **Commission Workshop on 8/31/26** to be held at 10am. Staff spent a great deal of time compiling research it had gathered, responding to the feedback received at the open house and incorporating it into the power point presentation for Monday. This has been distributed as well.

-Plan and Permit Reviews- Planning staff continues to provide comments at DRC Meetings and attend field visits for historic preservation permits.

-Planning Website- Active Zoning Text Amendments scheduled for hearings for the PB and CC will be posted on the website so that citizens can get the latest on what is being proposed.

-2081 12th Street- The wall mural has been completed at the Canned Ham Vintage Building. A ceremony will be scheduled in the near future.

Project Update

-Aspinwall Street Vacation- This was approved at the PB Meeting on 6/10/26 and approved at the CC Meeting on 8/3/26. The Second Reading is scheduled for the **CC Meeting on 9/8/26**.

-Batch ZTAs- These are scheduled to go to the **PB Meeting on 9/9/26**.

-The Bay ZTA- These are projected to go to the **PB Meeting on 10/14/26**.

-Composting ZTA- This is projected to go to the **PB Meeting on 10/14/26**.

-Comprehensive Plan Update- The Transportation Chapter Update was approved at the PB Meeting on 5/13/26 and was approved to be transmitted to the State at the CC Meeting on 8/3/26. This is projected to go to the **CC Meeting on 10/5/26**.

A public open house on the Inter-Governmental Coordination Chapter was held on 7/23/26. A meeting with the Argus Foundation was held on 6/5/26. Meetings were held with two CCNA Board members on 6/8/26 and the Chamber of Commerce on 6/12/26.

Conceptual goals of the Historic Preservation Chapter were discussed at the HPB Meeting on 5/12/26.

A meeting was held with CCNA Board members on the Recreation and Open Space Chapter on 8/18/26 and a presentation was given to the PREP Board on 8/20/26.

-Condo Hotels- A discussion on this topic was held at the CC Meeting on 7/20/26 and staff was directed to research and look into preparing a ZTA.

-Mobile Food Trucks in Downtown Bayfront ZTA- This was discussed at the CC Meeting on 7/6/26 and staff was directed to prepare a ZTA for this issue. This has been added to the Batch ZTA package which is scheduled to go to the **PB Meeting on 9/9/26.**

-1819 Wisteria Street- An appeal of the HPB's decision to deny a demolition permit is scheduled to go to the **CC Meeting on 9/8/26.**

-1660 Ringling Boulevard Comprehensive Plan Amendment- This was approved at the PB Meeting on 7/8/26 and was approved at the CC Meeting on 8/17/26. This is scheduled for Second Reading at the **CC Meeting on 9/8/26.**
